No inscribed marker.

James, Jr.

No inscribed marker. Shot and killed by Wash Evins at Old Cross Keys. The shooting was the result of a quarrel which took place between the two men at the sale of the property of James W. Reeve in the summer of 1852.

Note: According to the DeKalb County records, the perishable property of James W. Reeve was sold on Nov. 24, 1852. No record of a prior sale.

Died Nov. 30, 1882. Aged 52 years.

W. H.

Oct. 26, 1815 - May 24, 1903.
